THE IMPORTANCE OF UPSTREAM SOLUTIONS...

Fifty percent of policies in the database are upstream solutions. Upstream policy solutions are those that reduce **demand** for tobacco products, mitigating upstream environmental impacts from growing, curing, manufacturing, and transporting tobacco products in addition to addressing post-consumer waste (litter). The Statewide Microplastics strategy states upstream source reduction is the most effective response to microplastic pollution. Examples of upstream TPW policies include:

- Banning the sale of single-use cigarette filters
- Banning the sale of single-use electronic cigarettes
- Comprehensive Tobacco Retail Licenses
- Tobacco Retailer Density Restrictions
